

In a thrilling start to this year's CAF Women's Champions League CECAFA qualifying tournament, the Commercial Bank of Ethiopia (CBE) held off a determined Rayon Sports from Rwanda to secure a 3-2 victory at Abebe Bikila Stadium in Addis Ababa on Saturday.
