The 2026 CECAFA Kagame Cup continues on Sunday with two matches on the schedule as teams battle for crucial points in the regional tournament.

The day's action begins with KVZ FC of Zanzibar taking on Al Hilal Omdurman of Sudan in the afternoon before attention shifts to the evening fixture between Rayon Sports and Tusker FC of Kenya.

For Rayon, the clash presents an opportunity to strengthen their position in the competition against one of East Africa's most consistent clubs. Tusker, meanwhile, will be looking to build momentum as the group stage gathers pace.

Earlier on Saturday, Jamus SC of South Sudan boosted their campaign with a convincing 2-0 victory over Tanzania's Singida Black Stars.

Jamus produced a disciplined performance, taking their chances at key moments to secure all three points and keep themselves firmly in contention for a place in the knockout stage.

In the day's other fixture, Simba SC of Tanzania were held to a goalless draw by Mogadishu City Club of Somalia.

Despite dominating possession for long spells, Simba were unable to find a breakthrough against a buoyant Mogadishu City side that defended resolutely to earn a valuable point.

Sunday's matches are expected to further shape the race for qualification as the tournament enters a decisive stage, with every point becoming increasingly important.
