

A delegation of students and faculty members from Kenya National Defence College is in Rwanda for a study tour from 4 to 11 December 2020.

On December 7, 2020 the delegation led by the College's faculty member, Maj Gen Rashid Abdi Elmi, paid a courtesy call to the RDF Chief of Defence Staff General Jean Bosco KAZURA and were briefed on the roles and organisation of the Rwanda Defence Force.
