

Rwanda's Minister of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation, Ambassador Olivier Nduhungirehe met on Sunday with Qatari Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman bin Jassim Al-Thani during an official visit to Doha.

The two officials discussed bilateral relations and explored ways to strengthen cooperation between Rwanda and Qatar, according to a statement from Qatar's Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
