

Moroccan medical aid destined for Djibouti, as part of a package of aid granted, on High Instructions from His Majesty Mohammed VI, King of Morocco, to several African countries to support them in their efforts to fight coronavirus, arrived Monday 22nd of June 2020, at Djibouti international airport.
