

Rharb Youssef and Ugandan Charles Bbaale were the stars of the show as Rayon Sports FC put 2-1 past Gasogi FC in the opening season game at Gasogi stadium.

In the 11th minute of the first half, Bbaale broke the deadlock and Youssef added another six minutes later – probably the pick of the bunch – to highlight Zelfani Yamen's team's positive start to the season.

As a consequence, Gasogi FC worked their way back into the game to score a consolation in the 80th minute. Theodor Malipangou stepped up and slotted in a glorious penalty to reduce Gasogi FC's deficit to 2-1.
