

The Minister of Health Sabin Nsanzimana met with a delegation from Pfizer led by Elif Aral. Their discussions focused on the implementation of the Accord for a Healthier World in Rwanda.

Accord for a Healthier World is a Pfizer initiative with a vision to accelerate equitable access to high-quality medicines and vaccines to improve the health of people. Following its launch in Davos in May 2022, Rwanda became one of the first countries to implement this initiative.

Pfizer Inc. is an American multinational pharmaceutical and biotechnology corporation headquartered on 42nd Street in Manhattan, New York City. The company was established in 1849 in New York by two German entrepreneurs, Charles Pfizer (1824–1906) and his cousin Charles F. Erhart (1821–1891). (End)
