

Donatille Mukabalisa, Rwanda Speaker of Parliament was over the weekend December 11 re-elected for her second term as the president of the Liberal Party (PL).

She won majority votes during an ordinary congress.

Mukabalisa was first elected as president in 2016 to replace Protas Mitali who was accused of embezzling Rwf63 million (\$0.09 million) from the party's account.



Speaking during the congress, she urged the party members to work together by focusing on playing their role in national developments.
