

Star Times Rwanda has launched new television channel that will show international movies in Kinyarwanda language.

Ganza, a 24/7 channel will address concerns of foreign film enthusiasts in Rwanda who are unable to watch and enjoy western movies because of their limited command of the language, according to CEO Frankly Wang.

Ganza ‘s launch comes a few years after the launch Magic sports that broadcasts the national football league ‘The Rwanda Premier League’.
